**Mission:** To serve individuals with physical, cognitive and emotional disabilities and hardship by providing equine activities and therapeutic riding to empower, inspire, nurture and succeed.

Our goal is to focus on the abilities of our participants, and our hard working team of therapy horses and ponies help them achieve, aspire and amaze.

Our riders must be 5 years old and there is a 180 lb weight limit at this time. To make this happen, we need up to 3 volunteers per rider. Southern Reins volunteers must:

- Be 14 years or older
- Attend a mandatory New Volunteer training (see dates below)
- Complete our Volunteer Application including a liability waiver
- Be fit enough to walk/jog in a ring alongside our mounted riders.

There are several different volunteer roles:

*Side Walkers*: Sidewalkers walk beside the horse in lessons and provide physical and/or emotional support to the rider. They help the rider to successfully reach their lesson goals, as well as ensure rider safety before, during and after the lesson.

*Horse Leaders:* Horse Leaders ensure that each horse is groomed, tacked and warmed up prior to the start of each lesson. They help ensure the safety of horse and rider before, during and after the lesson. Horse Leaders also help with un-tacking and grooming horses after the lesson. Horse Leaders must possess a basic understanding of horse behavior and demonstrate horse handling skills and the ability to assess and address horse behavior. Prior to handling horses or leading them in client sessions, volunteers with this prerequisite knowledge must attend and pass mandatory horse leader training.
